## Rabbi Micah Friedman

L'Shanah Tovah! Here's to a good new year for all of us!

At this point in the year, Jewish communities all around the world are in the midst of preparing for our Fall season of Holy Days. In the middle of September, on the first of the Hebrew month Tishrei, we celebrate Rosh HaShanah, followed by Yom Kippur, Sukkot, Shemini Atzeret, and Simchat Torah.

Over the past several weeks, a great group of us has been gathering on Wednesday evenings to learn more about the building blocks of traditional Jewish prayer and the special flairs we add to our prayers on these holidays. I have been uplifted by the comments, questions, and contributions of the participants in the class and hope we can create more contexts to gather together and learn from each other.

One example of these flairs are the special words which we add to some of the last blessings of our tefillah (prayer) on Rosh HaShanah, Yom Kippur, and the days in between them. In the final blessing, the blessing for shalom (peace and wholeness), we add these words to our prayers:

In the book of life, blessing, peace, prosperity, may we be remembered and written before You- us and all of your people the house of Israel - for good lives and for peace.

This simple addition to our *tefillah* reflects the heart of Jewish prayer. We aspire to lives of goodness worthy of being remembered and recounted. As human beings, at our core we yearn to live good lives and as Jews we have inherited a charge to be a channel for blessing, peace, and well-being.

When we gather together for the High Holy Days, we articulate this desire collectively - we join together with all of our community and all of the Jewish communities across time and space who pray for lives of goodness and peace.

Over these past two months, I have been blessed to listen to so many stories from the lives of the people who make up our community. It is truly an honor to have the opportunity to lend a compassionate ear to someone as they share about the trajectory of their life, their connection to Jewish community, and their hopes for the future. If we have not yet had the chance to sit down together, one-on-one, I pray that we will be able to do so in this new year.

Through developing our relationships with each other, sharing our stories and dreams, we work together to write a shared book of life. So too, when we come together to pray, we become like collaborative authors writing the next chapter of the book of life of our congregation.

Let's join together in writing a chapter filled with goodness and blessing, for us, for all of the Jewish people, and all of creation.

Dear Members and friends of Temple Israel,

Leaves may be starting to drop, but at Temple Israel it feels like spring! New initiatives are blossoming and as we enter the season of renewal. We are privileged to welcome Rabbi Micah Friedman and his partner Rabbi Talia Laster to our synagogue family. We have also added a number of new members to our roster over the summer, and some are already active in our committees. Rabbi Friedman has jumped in with both feet and his scholarship and enthusiasm has already been impactful in numerous ways.

Under Rabbi Friedman's leadership, our season of repentance was launched with a very meaningful Tisha b'Av observance, and he has been teaching a class over the past five Wednesdays to orient us to the High Holidays. Despite the distractions of summer, participation has increased week by week. Our renewed Adult Education Committee is planning joint events with Temple Concord, and TI Hebrew School planning is underway as well. Over the summer the beauty of our building and grounds was further enhanced by the landscaping efforts of volunteers including Larry Hurwitz and Arlene Osber. Major new plantings were added, as well as new artwork and furniture, all donated by Sandra & Fred Weitsman.

Thanks to each and every one of you for doing your part to support the financial needs of our synagogue. We rely on your dues, donations, and personal participation to deliver our services, classes, and programs. To all who joined in the farewell to Rabbi Brown and the simcha of writing in our sacred Torah scrolls - yasher koach and mazel tov! It was a meaningful milestone in many ways - we expressed our appreciation to Rabbi Brown, seventy-five of us took the opportunity to actually write in our scrolls, and we raised over \$17,000. The Torah Rededication Fund will remain open for future donations.

The Safety and Security Committee has continued to implement essential procedures and provide training to prevent or deal with emergencies that may arise. Please register to attend relevant emergency response training sessions sponsored by the Jewish Federation.

Our Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur services will be led by Rabbi Friedman, and feature Sheldon Horowitz as our Cantor. Chazzan Horowitz has experience leading High Holiday Services in NYC, on Long Island, and in Florida. Both Rabbi and Cantor have very engaging styles and have been working together over the summer to prepare, so we are looking forward to a highly participatory service. As always, our lay daveners will also take many roles in our services. At present, we do not plan to limit attendance, but depending on the local Covid statistics, masking will likely be encouraged and we request social-distancing to the extent practical. Services will be streamed on Zoom at the usual TI Services Link. Once again, the costs of delivering these services will be underwritten by the Rozen Foundation. This year our Honeygram chairbees are offering honey bear cubs, candies and Rosh Hashanah greetings to be sent to members, friends, and family - locally and across the country.
